Approval of Minutes

March 18, 2026 Regular Meeting

The Board reviewed the minutes from the March 18, 2026 regular meeting.

Reports

Financial Presentations: Treasurer's Report presentation and approval

Chief York presented the March 2026 Treasurer's Report and reviewed the March check report with the Board.

Upon motion by Director Graham, seconded by Director McCartney, the Board voted unanimously to approve the March 2026 Treasurer's Report.

Chief's Report

Chief York presented the Chief's Report to the Board, reviewed monthly statistics for March and provided updates on significant events.

March has been a busy month for the department. March 21-30, CHFD was assisted on the 24 Fire. The 22nd of March there was a car that ran into a mobile home. On March 24, we had a structure fire on Cree Dr. The crew's response did a great job in containing it to the unit of origin in the six-plex unit. Unfortunately, it was a total loss of house. We also had a shed fire a few days later.

Chief York updated the board on Sales Tax. There was a lack of communication from the State to business owners. Business owners were under the assumption that this was automatically added to their accounts, but it was not. We have reached out to business owners to assist with instructions on updating their accounts. Other departments have also had similar issues with sales tax and the State.

Chief York informed there was a sewage backup in Station 1. This was budgeted for, as it was known it needed replacement. The repair has now been completed sooner than expected.

Type 3 and Type 1 engines should be here before June 1. New Ambulance is expected in July.

Hiring processes are completed. New hires start on the 26th. The Engine Boss position just closed. The only outstanding position is the Fire Inspector, expected to fly soon.

Two Phoenix awards will be given next week. Two different shifts being recognized for this life saving award.

Chief York gave an update on Wildland season. It is a busy season thus far. A crew deployed for fire outside of Trinidad this morning. Director E. Gass asked if people are fined when under a fire ban and have fire pits. Chief York informed it is possible to be charged by the Sheriff's office if there is a stage 1 or stage 2 fire ban.

Fire and Life Safety Report

Chief Joyce provided an overview of Life Safety and Fire Prevention activities for March, 2026.

Chief Joyce provided an update on the Highway 24 roundabout. He is working with patrol to allow patrons to take a left turn during this construction. Hopeful to be finished by spring 2027, possibly by winter 2026.

Chief Joyce stated he is looking at mid-June to mid-July to start clean up of the rock island trail head. A lot of businesses have stated they would participate and volunteer in this project.

Unfinished Business

Facilities Update

Chief York provided an update on the Valley Street remodel project. The metal siding came in and is 90% complete. This week and next week are insulation. We are on track for the end of July.

The offer for current headquarters has been sent to Cherokee. May 27th is response deadline. The inspection list for Headquarters is 98% done at this point.

Next Regular Meeting

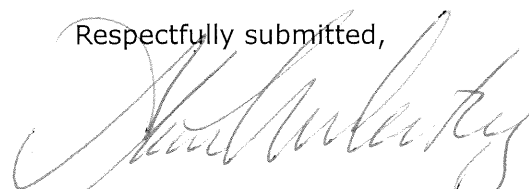
